New High Commissioner of Mozambique pays courtesy visit to Speaker Farrugia

High Commissioner of the Republic of Mozambique César Francisco de Gouveia Junior paid a courtesy visit to Speaker of the House of Representatives Anġlu Farrugia.

Speaker Farrugia and the High Commissioner spoke about the cordial relations that exist between Malta and Mozambique, which were diplomatically established on 18 May 2009.

Speaker Farrugia mentioned the various education opportunities offered by Malta, particularly MEDAC, IMLI, ITS, and the Medical School. He exhorted the High Commissioner to encourage Mozambican students to come to Malta and follow the post-graduate course at these University institutions.

The two dignitaries also discussed issues of mutual interest such as COVID-19, the Commonwealth, and their countries' relations with the European Union.
