A BILL
entitled

AN ACT to repeal the Entertainments Tax Act, Cap. 243.

BE IT ENACTED by the President, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Representatives, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title and commencement.
Cap. 243.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Entertainments Tax (Repeal) Act, 1995, and shall be read and construed as one with the Entertainments Tax Act, hereinafter referred to as “the principal Act”.

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st January, 1995.

Repeal of the principal Act.

2. The principal Act is hereby repealed.

Saving.

3. Notwithstanding the provisions of this Act, the provisions of the principal Act shall continue to apply fully with respect to any entertainment organised before the coming into force of this Act.

Objects and Reasons

The Object of this Bill is to abolish entertainments tax as announced by the Minister of Finance in the Budget Speech for 1995.
