This office has completed architectural designs regarding a large complex situated within Smart City. Such complex is to serve as a possible location for the relocation of ITS school in Pembroke. The idea is to have a hospitality campus whereby all players in the industry may study, graduate and practice.

We have completed the designs under the supervision and assistance of ITS Chairman Mr Paulino Schembri. We have also made a preliminary presentation to the Prime Minister and Chief of Staff. In a separate meeting, Mepa have also been presented with the project. Mepa CEO present.

The fees related to the project are standard Penit fees according to Tarif K and maybe summarised as follows:

Architectural Design up to Mepa permits	2%
Structure Design	2%
Bills of quantities and tender documentation	1%
Measuring of works	1%
Supervision	1%

The percentages excluding Vat are calculated on demolition, excavation, construction, landscaping and facade finishes works. (Basically those works under our responsibility) Mechanical and electrical services and internal finishes are excluded.

TIS, EIA's and land surveying are not included. However Smart City Malta would have carried out these in the Master Plan Stage.
