Onorevoli Speaker,

F'isem il-Kummissjoni għandi l-pjaċir nibgħatlek il-Programm ta' Hidma tal-Kummissjoni 2015 kif ipprezentat illum.

B'dan il-Programm ta' Hidma l-Kummissjoni beħsiebha timmarka bidu gdid għall-mod kif nahdmu fil-livell tal-UE. Iċ-ċittadini jistnew li l-Unjoni Ewropea tagħmel differenza fl-isfidi ekonomiċi u soċjali l-kbar, u ma tidholx f'oqsma fejn l-Istati Membri jkunu jistgħu jaġixxu f'pożizzjoni aħjar minnha. L-approċċ il-gdid mhux se japplika biss għall-inizjattivi futuri tal-Kummissjoni imma se japplika wkoll għall-proposti li jinsabu digà fuq il-mejda u għall-corpus legiżlattiv eżistenti. Dan il-Programm ta' Hidma għalhekk jidentifika wkoll il-proposti pendenti li l-Kummissjoni qed tipproponi li tirtira, kif ukoll l-azzjonijiet ewlenin skont il-Programm ta' Idoneità Regulatorja tagħha.

Il-Pjan ta' Investiment għall-Ewropa adottat fis-26 ta' Novembru se jservi ta' ispirazzjoni u ta' mutur għall-azzjonijiet skont il-programm tal-2015. Elementi ewlenin oħrajn ta' hidmitna jinkludu miżuri biex nibnu suq uniku għall-kontenut diġitali, noħolqu Unjoni tal-Energija, niehdu azzjoni effikaċi kontra l-frodi u l-evażjoni fiskali, insaħħu l-Unjoni Ekonomika u Monetarja u l-governanza ekonomika tagħha kif ukoll nagħtu spinta lis-swieq kapitali, u niżviluppaw approċċ olistiku għall-gestjoni tal-migrazzjoni minn pajjiżi terzi.

Il-ħolqien ta' sħubija għda mal-Parlamenti nazzjonali hija prijorità għal din il-Kummissjoni u nixtieq nikkonferma li l-Membri tal-Kummissjoni huma lesti li jżuru l-Parlamenti nazzjonali, jekk jintalbu jaġmlu dan, biex jipprezentaw u jiddiskutu l-Programm ta' Hidma.

Nawguralek l-isbah xewqat għas-Sena l-Għda u herqan li nkomplu bid-djalogu politiku tagħna fl-2015.

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INTRODUZZJONI

Din il-Kummissjoni ngħatat il-mandat tal-kariga b'impenn biex tagħmel differenza: biex tagħmel affarijiet differenti u tagħmilhom b'mod differenti. Iċ-ċittadini jistennu li l-UE tagħmel differenza fejn jidhlu l-isfidi ekonomiċi u soċjali kbar — rata għolja ta' qgħad, tkabbir kajman, livelli għoljin ta' dejn pubbliku, differenzi fl-investment u nuqqas ta' kompetittività fis-suq globali. U jridu anqas interferenza mill-UE fi kwistjonijiet fejn l-Istati Membri huma mgħammra ahjar biex jagħtu reazzjoni fil-livell nazzjonali u reġjonali. Jistennu ukoll li l-UE tkun aktar miftuħa u responsabbli dwar dak li tagħmel u kif tagħmlu.

Din il-Kummissjoni hija determinata li tmexxi 'l quddiem din il-bidla, u li taħdem mal-Parlament Ewropew u mal-Kunsill biex tara li dan isehh. Din hija r-raġuni għaliex se niffukaw fuq il-"hwejjeġ il-kbar", bhall-impjiegi u t-tkabbir, f'konformità mal-ghaxar prijoritajiet tal-Linji Gwida Poliċi tal-President Juncker¹. Ahna mhux se nipprezentaw proposti li ma jkunux ta' kontribut għal dawn il-prijoritajiet. U ser napplikaw diskontinwità politika² u se nwarbu minn fuq l-aġenda proposti pendenti li ma jkunux konformi mal-obiettivi tagħna jew li ma jkollhom l-ebda sens ta' direzzjoni, għaliex ahna rridu li l-istituzzjonijiet kollha jiffokaw fuq it-twettiq ta' dak li verament huwa importanti.

Dan huwa l-impenn politiku tagħna, u fuq dik il-bażi rridu nilhqu lil hinn mill-bażi ta' Brussell madwar l-UE sabiex terġa' tinbena l-kundifenza u terġa' tinkiseb il-fiduċja taċ-ċittadini tal-UE. Iċ-ċittadini se jiġġudikawna skont l-impenn u r-rizultati li niksbu, fuq it-titjib li huma jaraw f'hajjithom bħala rizultat. Fl-ewwel xahar tagħna fil-kariga ahna ressaqna pakkett maġġuri dwar l-impjiegi, it-tkabbir u l-investment³ flimkien ma' Pjan ta' Investment ġdid biex jiġu mmobilizzati aktar minn EUR 315-il biljun f'investimenti addizzjonali f'oqsma strateġiċi matul it-tliet snin li ġejjin. Irridu li nkomplu kif bdejna.

Il-proposti li qed inħabbu f'dan il-Programm ta' Hidma ntgħazlu għaliex nemmnu li dawn jistgħu jagħmlu differenza fejn jidhlu l-impjiegi, it-tkabbir u l-investment u li jistgħu jwasslu għal benefiċċji konkreti għaċ-ċittadini s-sena d-diehla. Dak li ahna qed nimpjenjaw ruħna għalih f'dan il-Programm ta' Hidma huma l-affarijiet li se nwettqu fl-2015. Ahna ser nipproponu azzjonijiet oħra biex inwettqu l-ghaxar prijoritajiet fil-programmi ta' hidma

tagħna għas-snin li gejjin — il-ħidma preparatorja fil-każ ta' xi wħud minn dawn se tibda fl-2015.

Iżda l-parti l-kbira ta' dak li jiġri fl-UE llum, u l-mod kif iċ-ċittadini tagħna jqisu lill-UE huma bbażati fuq il-legiżlazzjoni u l-programmi eżistenti. Il-preokkupazzjonijiet immedjati tagħhom huma dwar il-ġabra tar-regoli eżistenti, u din hija r-raġuni għaliex il-Kummissjoni qed tagħmel bħala prijorità politika t-tnaqqis tal-piż regolatorju filwaqt li jinżammu livelli għoljin ta' protezzjoni soċjali, tas-saħħa u ambjentali u l-għażla għall-konsumatur. Aħna se nagħmlu riformi drastici fir-regoli biex jiġi żgurat li dawn jikkontribwixxu għall-aġenda tal-impjiegi u t-tkabbir u ma jkunux tali li jimponu piżijiet burokratiċi jew piżijiet amministrattivi, filwaqt li fl-istess ħin jipprovdu l-benefiċċji li iċ-ċittadini jistennaw. Fejn ir-regoli huma skaduti jew ma jirriflettux il-prijoritajiet tagħna, aħna ser nirveduhom u ntejbuhom. Fejn hemm burokrazija mhux meħtieġa, se neliminawha. Fejn ir-regoli li għandna jagħmlu sens u jservu l-għanijiet tagħna, ser naħdmu b'mod attiv biex niżguraw li dawn jiġu applikati sewwa, implimentati u infurzati sabiex iwasslu għal benefiċċji reali għaċ-ċittadini. U aħna se nużaw l-għodod l-oħra li għandna għad-dispożizzjoni tagħna biex immexxu 'l quddiem l-impjiegi u t-tkabbir, b'mod partikolari il-baġit tal-UE li huwa primarjament mezz għal investiment intelligenti fl-Istati Membri u r-regjuni.

Din hija agenda għall-bidla, imwiġda mill-ħtieġa li l-UE terġa' tibda tikber sabiex il-mudell soċjali u ambjentali Ewropew, flimkien ma' ambjent b'saħħtu, ikun jista' jiġi sostnut fil-futur.

Hija wkoll sejha għal bidla fil-metodi ta' ħidma tal-Parlament Ewropew u tal-Kunsill. Irridu naħdmu magħhom biex niddefinixxu l-prijoritajiet ewlenin madwar it-tliet istituzzjonijiet u biex inħaffu t-teħid ta' deċiżjonijiet fihom, sabiex l-effetti pożittivi tal-proposti tagħna jkunu jistgħu jintlaħqu malajr miċ-ċittadini. Aħna se nibnu sħubija aktar mill-qrib mal-Istati Membri, il-Parlamenti nazzjonali, ir-regjuni u l-ibliet sabiex ikollna implimentazzjoni aħjar tal-politiki eżistenti u tal-effettività ta' azzjoni fuq il-post, mill-użu tal-fondi strutturali għall-politika ambjentali, mis-suq uniku għad-drittijiet tal-konsumatur.

Sabiex terġa' tiġi stabbilita l-fiduċja, hemm il-ħtieġa li l-bidla tkun waħda li tidher⁴ u li jkollha impatt malajr. B'dan il-programm ta' ħidma — u bl-implimentazzjoni tiegħu fl-2015 — irridu nagħtu prova li din id-darba l-affarijiet huma differenti.

Dan il-Programm ta' Ħidma jippreżenta azzjonijiet iffokati għall-2015. Ma jidholx fid-dettall dwar dak li se tagħmel il-Kummissjoni fl-erba' snin sussegwenti tal-mandat tagħha anki jekk se tibda l-ħidma preparatorja fi kwistjonijiet bħalma huma r-reviżjoni ta' nofs it-terminu tal-

qafas finanzjarju pluriennali. L-Anness I jippreżenta l-inizjattivi l-godda, organizzati madwar il-prijoritajiet prinċipali tal-Linji Gwida Poliċi, li l-Kummissjoni se tikkonċentra l-isforzi tagħha fl-2015 fuqhom.

Fit-thejjija ta' dan il-programm ta' hidma, il-Kummissjoni eżaminat il-proposti kollha li bħalissa qed jistennew deċiżjoni mill-Parlament Ewropew u mill-Kunsill⁵. Ahna nqisu li l-applikazzjoni tal-prinċipju ta' diskontinwità politika bħala parti importanti tar-responsabbiltà politika tagħna: hemm bżonn li ssir tindifa sabiex ikunu jistgħu jiġu investiti l-hin u l-enerġija f'dawk il-proposti li se jkollhom l-akbar impatt fuq it-tkabbir u l-impjiegi u li jkollhom prospetti tajba li jiġu adottati fil-futur qrib.

Iffurmajna opinjoni dwar il-proposti li nixtiequ nżommu, u li rridu naraw li jiġu adottati, dawk li qed nippjanaw li nemendaw sabiex ingibuhom konformi mal-ghaxar prijoritajiet tagħna u dawk li qed nipproponu li nirtiraw. Il-Kummissjoni għadha impenjata bis-shih dwar l-oġettivi ta' hafna mill-proposti li qed tipproponi li tirtira. Izda l-proposti ma jkollhom l-ebda siwi jekk sempliċement jibqgħu riekda fuq il-mejda tan-negozjati, jekk isiru irrelevantni minhabba xi żviluppi, jew jekk matul in-negozjati jiddgħajfu sal-punt fejn ma jkunux jistgħu aktar jiksbu l-iskop inizjali tagħhom. F'xi każi, il-Kummissjoni qed tipproponi li tirtira proposti sabiex tissostitwihom sussegwentement bi proposti aktar ambizzjużi jew biex tfassalhom b'mod li jkun aktar qrib l-ghaxar prijoritajiet tagħha. F'każi oħra, is-soċjetà mxiet 'il quddiem minn mindu kienu saru l-proposti oriġinali mill-Kummissjoni. L-Anness II jelenka l-proposti li għandhom jiġu rtirati (jew emendati). Il-Kummissjoni qed tistenna l-fehmiet tal-Parlament Ewropew u tal-Kunsill dwar dawn il-proposti qabel ma tipproċedi bl-irtirar.

Il-Programm ta' Hidma jirrifletti wkoll l-impenn tal-Kummissjoni għal Regolamentazzjoni Aħjar. Din hija fil-qalba tal-programm tal-Kummissjoni dwar l-Idoneità u l-Prestazzjoni tar-Regolamentazzjoni li għandu l-ghan li jaqta' l-burokrazija u jneħhi l-piżijiet regolatorji. L-azzjonijiet li fih – emendi legiżlattivi, testijiet u evalwazzjonijiet ta' idoneità – jiffurmaw element ċentrali tal-hidma tal-Kummissjoni u huma ppreżentati fl-Anness III. Se jitniedu, pereżempju, sforzi għas-simplifikazzjoni tal-Politika Agrikola Komuni. Se jkun hemm ukoll hidma ffukata biex ir-riforma reċenti tas-servizzi finanzjarji, il-Politika Komuni tas-Sajd u r-regoli l-godda għall-Fondi Ewropej Strutturali u ta' Investiment 2014-2020 jibdedw joperaw bla xkiel. Dan jirrikjedi koordinazzjoni u involviment fil-livelli kollha tal-partijiet interessati kollha — il-bini ta' netwerks u l-iskambju ta' esperjenzi u tal-aħjar Prattiki f'oqsma ta' politika differenti.

Biex tinforma aħjar liċ-ċittadini u lill-kumpaniji ta' meta l-ligijiet tal-UE jidhlu fis-seħh, il-Programm ta' Hidma jelenka legiżlazzjoni li ssir applikabbli fl-2015 fl-Anness IV.

1. Spinta ġdida għall-Impjiegi, it-Tkabbir u l-Investment

In-narrattiva ekonomika l-ġdida tal-Kummissjoni hija mibnija madwar tliet linji ewlenin - l-ispinta lill-investment, it-tkomplija tar-riformi strutturali u r-responsabilità fiskali. Fi shubija mill-qrib mal-Bank Ewropew tal-Investment, il-Kummissjoni pproponiet pjan ta' investment importanti⁶ biex tingħata spinta ġdida lill-impjiegi, it-tkabbir u l-investment fl-Ewropa. Il-finanzjament addizzjonali għall-investimenti l-ġodda se jiġi mmobilizzati permezz ta' Fond Ewropew ġdid għal investimenti strateġiċi u billi jiġi żgurat li dan jilhaq l-ekonomija reali permezz tal-istabbiliment ta' linja ta' proġetti kredibbli u bl-espansjoni u l-faċilitazzjoni tal-aċċess għal assistenza teknika.

Barra mill-Fond il-ġdid, l-użu ta' strumenti finanzjarji innovattivi (pereżempju self u garanziji, minflok għotjiet) se jkompli jiġi promoss biex jiżded l-impatt tal-Fondi Strutturali u ta' Investment Ewropej għall-perjodu mill-2014 sal-2020, bl-oġettiv ta' mill-inqas l-irduppar tal-użu ta' tali strumenti fil-perjodu ta' programmazzjoni l-ġdid.

Miżuri addizzjonali ser ikunu ffukati fuq it-tiġib tal-ambjent tan-negozju, it-tneħħija ta' ostakli regolatorji u mhux regolatorji għall-investment, u tishih ulterjuri tas-Suq Uniku. Il-Kummissjoni se tressaq diversi proposti maħsuba biex jimplimentaw malajr dan l-approċċ u se tkompli teżamina r-regoli applikabbli dwar l-ghajnuna mill-Istat.

Hekk kif il-Ftehimiet ta' Shubija kollha għall-Fondi Strutturali u ta' Investment Ewropej 2014-2020 issa ġew approvati, u l-programmi operattivi li baqa' qed jiġu ffinalizzati, l-investment fuq l-ghanijiet ta' Ewropa 2020⁷ dwar it-tkabbir intelligenti, sostenibbli u inklussiv għandu jibda jagħti l-frott fl-2015. Il-politika ta' koeżjoni l-ġdida, ankrata fil-profond fil-proċess tas-semestru Ewropew u l-proċess ta' governanza ekonomika, sar is-sors prinċipali tal-investimenti pubbliku f'diversi Stati Membri.

Il-massimizzazzjoni tal-impatt tal-baġit tal-UE fuq l-impjiegi, it-tkabbir u l-investment b'għarfien imġedded tal-htieġa li jittejjeb il-mod kif jintefqu l-flus pubbliċi se tkun parti mir-riflessjonijiet dwar ir-reviżjoni ta' nofs it-terminu tal-qafas finanzjarju pluriennali (QFP) u preparazzjonijiet għall-pakkett ta' wara l-QFP 2020, aktar tard matul il-mandat tal-Kummissjoni.

Il-Kummissjoni se tagħmel rieżami tal-istrategija tal-UE dwar il-politika ta' kummerċ u ta' investment b'attenzjoni partikolari għall-kontribut tagħha lejn l-impjiegi u t-tkabbir. Il-konsolidazzjoni tar-rabtiet kummerċjali u ta' investment tal-UE għal centri ġodda ta' tkabbir fid-dinja mhix biss essenzjali għall-impjiegi, it-tkabbir, u l-produttività msahha fl-UE, iżda għandha impatti importanti fuq il-politika tal-viċinat u tal-iżvilupp tagħna kif ukoll fuq il-partecipazzjoni tal-UE fl-istituzzjonijiet finanzjarji internazzjonali.

L-Istati Membri qed jaffaċċaw l-isfida diffiċli biex aktar nies jibdew jaħdmu, u li l-haddiema jkollhom il-hiliet li jehtiegu biex jimxu 'l quddiem u jadattaw ruħhom għall-impjiegi tal-gejjieni. Il-Kummissjoni se tippreżenta pakkett ta' miżuri biex tappoġġja dawn l-isforzi sabiex tinghata spinta lill-integrazzjoni fis-suq tax-xogħol u fil-promozzjoni tal-hiliet.

Legiżlazzjoni tal-UE abbozzata tajjeb u l-implimentazzjoni effettiva tagħha jista' jkollhom impatt kbir fuq l-impjiegi, it-tkabbir u l-innovazzjoni. L-industriji ekoloġiċi u l-eko-innovazzjoni attwalment jipprovdu terz tas-suq globali għal teknoloġiji ekoloġiċi, b'valur ta' triljun euro u dan mistenni li jirdoppja sal-2020. Il-proposta riveduta għall-ekonomija ċirkolari se ssahhaħ din ix-xejra u għalhekk se tkun qed tikkontribwixxi għat-tkabbir ekoloġiku. F'dan il-qasam huwa importanti li naqblu dwar objettivi komuni għal dak li rridu niksbu, b'livell xieraq ta' ambizzjoni, filwaqt li nkunu anqas preskrittivi dwar il-mezzi li l-Istati Membri jistgħu jużaw biex jikbsu dawn ir-riżultati, haġa li tagħmilha aktar faċli li l-proposti jissarrfu f'azzjoni konkreta.

L-UE għandha sistema regolatorja żviluppata sew. Attenzjoni mġedda fuq is-sinerġiji ta' implimentazzjoni u ta' esplorazzjoni bejn il-legiżlazzjoni eżistenti tista' twassal għal riżultati malajr, bil-holqien ta' opportunitajiet godda għall-impjiegi u t-tkabbir. Minbarra li tirrifirma l-legiżlazzjoni eżistenti biex tara li din tkun xierqa għall-iskop tagħha, il-Kummissjoni se taħdem ukoll mal-Istati Membri biex tara li mill-korp eżistenti tal-ligijiet tal-UE jiġi sfruttat il-potenzjal massimu għat-tkabbir. Dan se jkun l-ogħla prijorità f'haġna oqsma tal-hidma tagħna — l-agrikoltura, is-sajd, id-dwana, is-servizzi finanzjarji u s-Suq Uniku, biex insemmu xi wħud.

2. Suq Uniku Diġitali Konness

Is-Suq Uniku Diġitali huwa wieħed miċ-ċwieviet ewlenin lejn l-istabbiliment ta' dinamika ġdida madwar l-ekonomija Ewropea kollha kemm hi, li tkattar l-impjiegi, it-tkabbir, l-innovazzjoni u l-progress soċjali. L-oqsma kollha tal-ekonomija u tas-soċjeta qed isiru diġitali. L-Ewropa jehtieġ li tkun fuq quddiem ta' din ir-rivoluzzjoni diġitali għaċ-ċittadini u għan-negozji tagħha. L-ostakli quddiem is-sistemi diġitali huma ostakoli quddiem l-impjiegi, il-prosperità u l-progress.

Il-Kummissjoni qed thejji Strategija li biha se tidentifika l-isfidi ewlenin biex jitlesta Suq Uniku Diġitali li jkun sikur, ta' fiduċja u dinamiku. L-Istrategija se tiffoka fuq sitt linji: il-bini tal-fiduċja u l-kunfidenza, it-tneħħija ta' restrizzjonijiet, l-iżgurar tal-aċċess u tal-konnettività, il-bini tal-ekonomija Diġitali, il-promozzjoni tas-soċjeta elettronika u l-investment friċerka u innovazzjoni fl-ICT li jkunu ta' klassi dinjija.

Fl-2015, bħala parti mill-Istrategija tas-Suq Uniku Diġitali, il-Kummissjoni se jkollha l-għan li tikkonkludi n-negozjati interistituzzjonali li għaddejjin dwar proposti bħalma huma r-riforma komuni Ewropea tal-protezzjoni tad-dejta u r-Regolament dwar Kontinent Konness. Se tippromponi wkoll inizjattivi godda, kemm legiżlattivi kif ukoll mhux legiżlattivi, biex is-Suq Uniku Diġitali jingieb fil-livell ta' ambizzjoni meħtieġa biex jintlaqgħu l-isfidi eżistenti. F'dan il-kuntest, il-Kummissjoni b'mod notevoli se tikkumplimenta l-ambjent regolatorju ta'

telekomunikazzjoni, timmodernizza l-legizlazzjoni tal-UE dwar id-drittijiet tal-awtur u dwar is-servizzi tal-medja awdjoviziva, tissimplifika r-regoli għall-konsumaturi li jixtru onlajn u b'modi diġitali, tiffaċilita l-kummerċ elettroniku, ittejjeb iċ-ċibersigurtà u tintegra d-digitalizzazzjoni madwar l-oqsma politiċi kollha.

3. Unjoni tal-Energija Reżiljenti li jkollha Politika dwar it-Tibdil tal-Klima li Thares lejn il-Futur

Provvista tal-enerġija affidabbli u bi prezz aċċessibbli hija prijorità ewlenija għal kulhadd. Il-Kummissjoni se tadotta qafas strateġiku għall-unjoni tal-enerġija u qed tistabbilixxi l-azzjonijiet kruċjali li għandhom jittiehdu sabiex tkun żgurata s-sigurtà tal-forniment tal-enerġija, titnaqqas id-dipendenza fuq l-importazzjonijiet minn pajjiżi terzi, ikomplu jiġu integrati s-swieq nazzjonali tal-enerġija u tittejjeb il-partecipazzjoni tal-konsumaturi, tittejjeb l-effiċjenza tal-enerġija⁸, jonqos is-sehem tal-karburi fit-tahlita tal-enerġija u jiġu promossi r-riċerka u l-innovazzjoni fil-qasam tal-enerġija.

L-UE hija wkoll minn ta' quddiem fl-isforzi globali fil-għieda kontra t-tiġin globali. Il-Kummissjoni se tistabbilixxi l-viżjoni u l-aspettattivi tal-UE fiż-żmien li jwassal għall-Konferenza tal-Partijiet tal-Konvenzjoni-Qafas tan-Nazzjonijiet Uniti dwar it-Tibdil fil-Klima (UNFCCC) f'Parigi fi tmien l-2015 u se tibda tipprezenta l-proposti legizlattivi sabiex timplimenta l-pakkett tal-klima u l-enerġija tal-2030.

Se jkomplu l-isforzi biex jittejjeb il-qafas regolatorju għal servizzi ta' trasport interkonnessi, bla perikli, b'inqas emissorijiet ta' gassijiet b'effett ta' serra.

4. Suq Intern Aktar Ġust u Aktar Profond b'Bażi Industrijali Msahha

Is-suq uniku huwa wiehed mill-aqwa assi tal-Ewropa — il-potenzjal tiegħu għandu jkompli jiġi sfruttat biex tittejjeb il-kompetittività tal-Ewropa fis-suq globali u jinholqu l-impjiegi. Il-Kummissjoni se tipprezenta strateġija tas-suq intern biex jiġu stabbiliti approċċi godda biex jinqabad dan il-potenzjal.

Is-suq intern huwa wkoll il-pedament għas-sahha industrijali u l-kapaċità produttiva tal-Ewropa, li għandha tkompli tissahha. Iż-żieda fl-investment fl-infrastruttura u fl-SMEs u f'kumpaniji b'kapitalizzazzjoni medja, it-titjib tal-ambjent regolatorju u l-ghajnuna lill-kumpaniji biex jagħmlu innovazzjoni, pereżempju bl-appoġġ tal-programm Orizzont 2020, se jkun oqsma importanti ta' hidma. L-avjazzjoni qed tiffaċċja sfidi kbar. Il-Kummissjoni se teżamina modi biex jittejjeb l-kundizzjonijiet tas-settur billi tissahha il-kompetittività tagħha.

Il-Kummissjoni hija ferqana li tgħin lill-Istati Membri jnaqqsu l-qgħad permezz ta' riformi strutturali u appoġġ għall-holqien tal-impjiegi u tal-impjegabbiltà. Hija qiegħda fil-proċess li tidentifika modi biex tinvesti fl-għarfien u l-hiliet filwaqt li tingħata attenzjoni partikolari lill-gruppi l-aktar vulnerabbli bħaż-żgħażaġh qiegħda u dawk li ilhom qiegħda għal żmien twil. Se jkun importanti li l-mobbiltà tax-xogħol tiġi appoġġata, speċjalment f'kazijiet ta' postijiet vakanti persistenti u t-tlaqqiġh hazin tal-hiliet, inkluż bejn il-fruntieri, filwaqt li jiġi appoġġat ir-rwol tal-awtoritajiet nazzjonali fil-ġlieda kontra l-abbuż jew talbiet frodulent.

It-tlestija u l-implimentazzjoni tar-riforma sinifikanti tal-qafas regolatorju finanzjarju b'reazzjoni għall-kriżi finanzjarja, inkluża l-implimentazzjoni tar-regoli superviżoorji u ta' rizzoluzzjoni bankarji ġodda, għadu qasam ewlieni tal-hidma tal-Kummissjoni. Il-qafas regolatorju se jkompli jissahha permezz ta' proposta li tittratta l-immaniġġjar tal-kriżijiet u rizzoluzzjoni ta' entitajiet sistemici mhux bankarji. Il-Kummissjoni se tibda b'hidma preparatorja dwar kif is-suq uniku għas-servizzi finanzjarji għall-konsumaturi jista' jwassal għal aktar benefiċċji għall-konsumaturi.

Il-Kummissjoni se tfassal pjan ta' azzjoni biex tibni Unjoni tas-Swieq Kapitali, tesplora modi għat-tnaqqis tal-frammentazzjoni fis-swieq finanzjarji, id-diversifikazzjoni ta' sorsi ta' finanzjament għall-ekonomija sħiħa, it-titjib tal-aċċess għall-finanzi għall-SMEs u t-tisħiħ tal-flussi transkonfinali tal-kapital fis-suq uniku biex il-kapital ikun jista' jintuża bl-aktar mod produttiv. Fuq perjodu qasir ta' żmien, hija se tipproponi qafas għal titolizzazzjoni ta' kwalità għolja fl-Ewropa, it-titjib tal-informazzjoni ta' kreditu standardizzata għall-SMEs, u se tqis kif testendi l-iskemi, li kisbu suċċess, ta' pjazzament privat madwar l-UE u tirrevedi d-Direttiva Prospectus għat-tnaqqis tal-piżijiet amministrattivi fuq l-SMEs.

5. Unjoni Ekonomika u Monetarja Aktar Profonda u Aktar Ġusta

L-arkitettura tal-Unjoni Ekonomika u Monetarja tehtieg aktar tisħiħ sabiex l-euro jkun jista' jżomm il-fiduċja taċ-ċittadini, ikompli jaffaċċja t-taqlib fis-swieq u jinħolqu l-kundizzjonijiet għal tkabbir u impjiegi sostenibbli. Wara r-rieżami tar-regoli tal-governanza ekonomika u l-azzjonijiet biex jissimplifikaw u jirrazzjonalizzaw il-proċess tas-Semestru Ewropew, il-Kummissjoni qed taħdem fuq l-approfondiment tal-Unjoni Ekonomika u Monetarja, filwaqt li tiżviluppa proposti dwar passi ulterjuri lejn is-sovranià miġbura fil-governanza ekonomika. Dan l-isforz se jkun akkumpanjat minn azzjonijiet għat-tisħiħ tad-djalogu soċjali fil-livelli kollha.

Filwaqt li tiġi rikonoxxuta l-kompetenza tal-Istati Membri rigward is-sistemi ta' tassazzjoni tagħhom, il-Kummissjoni se żżid l-isforzi tagħha fil-ġlieda kontra l-evażjoni tat-taxxa u l-frodi tat-taxxa u twieġeb għas-sejha għall-ġustizzja u t-trasparenza fejn tidhol it-tassazzjoni li gejjja mis-soċjetajiet tagħna. Billi tibda mill-hidma li saret fuq l-erożjoni ta' bażi u t-trasferiment tal-profitti fil-livelli tal-OECD u tal-G20, il-Kummissjoni se tfassal Pjan ta' Azzjoni li jinkludi miżuri fil-livell tal-UE sabiex timxi lejn sistema fejn abbażi tagħha, il-pajjiż fejn jiġu ġġenerati l-profitti jkun ukoll il-pajjiż fejn issir it-tassazzjoni, inkluż fl-ekonomija diġitali, li tkun tirrekjedi ukoll ftehim dwar Bażi tat-Taxxa Komuni Konsolidata. F'dan il-kontest, il-Kummissjoni se tagħmel ukoll malajr proposta dwar l-iskambju

awtomatiku tal-informazzjoni bejn l-awtoritajiet tat-taxxa dwar deċiżjonijiet tat-taxxa transkonfinali. Barra minn hekk, il-Kummissjoni se taħdem mill-qrib mal-istituzzjonijiet l-oħra biex tinkoraġġixxi l-adozzjoni ta' taxxa fuq it-tranzazzjonijiet finanzjarji kif ukoll tišhih tar-regoli kontra l-ħasil tal-flus. Għadha għaddejja wkoll ħidma fil-qasam tal-VAT, inklużi miżuri biex tingħalaq id-differenza tat-taxxa.

6. Ftehim ta' Kummerċ Ħieles Raġonevoli u Bbilanċjat mal-Istati Uniti

Il-kummerċ jagħti kontribut importanti għall-impjiegi u t-*tkabbir*. Minbarra l-Ftehim ta' Shubija Trans-Atlantika ta' Kummerċ u ta' Investiment (TTIP) mal-Istati Uniti, il-Kummissjoni hija impenjata b'mod attiv f'għadd ta' negozjati bilaterali flimkien ma' impenn multilaterali b'saħħtu mad-WTO. Il-Kummissjoni diġà hadet passi biex iżżid it-trasparenza fin-negozjati dwar it-TTIP⁹, u qed tkompli taħdem lejn ftehim ibbilanċjat u raġonevoli, filwaqt li tissalvagwardja l-istandards Ewropew fejn jidhlu s-saħħa, il-politika soċjali, l-ambjent u l-protezzjoni tad-dejta kif ukoll id-diversità kulturali tagħha.

7. Żona ta' Ġustizzja u Drittijiet Fundamentali Bbażata fuq il-Fiduċja Reċiproka

Iċ-ċittadini jippretendu mill-UE l-*gustizzja*, il-protezzjoni, u l-istat tad-dritt, u li żżomm pożizzjoni soda fil-*għlieda* kontra l-forom kollha ta' diskriminazzjoni. Il-Kummissjoni se tkompli taħdem biex l-UE taderixxi mal-Konvenzjoni Ewropea dwar id-Drittijiet tal-Bniedem fid-dawl tal-linji gwida li dalwaqt mistennija johorġu mill-Qorti. Hija ser tkompli ttejjeb il-*għlieda* kontra l-kriminalità u t-terroriżmu transfruntier kif ukoll il-kooperazzjoni għudizzjarja għall-benefiċċju taċ-ċittadini madwar l-UE u f'hares il-baġit tal-UE mill-frodi, inkluż billi tkompli bl-isforzi biex tistabbilixxi Uffiċċju tal-Prosekutur Pubbliku Ewropew indipendenti.

Il-Kummissjoni Ewropea hija impenjata lejn l-*ugwaljanza* fl-*opportunitajiet* għal persuni b'diżabilità, b'rispett sħiħ tal-Konvenzjoni tan-NU dwar id-drittijiet ta' persuni b'diżabbiltà. Dan jinkludi l-*aċċessibbiltà* għall-ambjent fiżiku, għat-trasport, għall-informazzjoni u għat-teknoloġiji u sistemi ta' komunikazzjoni (ICT), u faċilitajiet jew servizzi oħra.

Il-Kummissjoni hija impenjata li tippromwovi l-*ugwaljanza* bejn l-irġiel u n-nisa, biex tippermetti li aktar nisa jieħdu sehem fis-suq tax-xoġhol. Fir-rigward tal-proposta dwar il-liv tal-maternità tal-2008, il-Kummissjoni se tirtiraha fi żmien sitt xhur, jekk ma jkunx possibbli li jiġu żblukkati n-negozjati. Dan għandu jippermetti li jkun hemm approċċ għdid li jhares lejn din il-kwistjoni fil-kuntest usa' tagħha, meta wieħed iqis ir-realtà tas-soċjetajiet tal-lum, u se tqis il-progress li jkun sar f'dan il-qasam fil-livell tal-Istati Membri.

Il-Kummissjoni se tippreżenta Agenda Ewropea dwar is-Sigurtà sabiex tindirizza t-theddid għas-sigurtà interna tal-UE bħalma huma l-kriminalità transfruntiera, iċ-ċiberkriminalità, it-

terroriżmu, il-ġellieda barranin u r-radikalizzazzjoni biex tghin lill-UE tiproteġi liċ-ċittadini tagħha filwaqt li tibqa' miftuħa għad-dinja.

8. Lejn Politika Ġdida dwar il-Migrazzjoni

Sabiex tiġi indirizzata l-persjoni dejjem tiżdied fil-fruntieri esterni tagħna, il-Kummissjoni qed tiżviluppa Agenda Ewropea dwar il-Migrazzjoni, li se tibbilanċja approċċ iktar ġust u raġjonevoli għall-migrazzjoni legali, sabiex l-UE ssir destinazzjoni attraenti għat-talenti u l-hiliet, b'miżuri stretti kontra l-migrazzjoni irregolari u t-traffikar u l-kuntrabandu tal-bnedmin. It-tiġib tal-ġestjoni tal-migrazzjoni t'fisser irbit aħjar bejn il-politika ta' migrazzjoni tagħna mal-politika esterna tagħna, it-trawwim ta' kooperazzjoni interna u esterna akbar, l-offerta tal-protezzjoni lill-persuni fil-bżonn, ibbażata fuq ir-responsabbiltà u s-solidarjetà u l-prevenzjoni ta' avvenimenti traġiċi bħal dawk li qegħdin isehhu ripetutament fil-Mediterran.

9. Attur Globali Aktar b'Saħtu

L-avvenimenti ta' dan l-aħħar poġġew fuq quddiem l-isfidi ġeopolitiċi, mhux l-inqas fuq il-fruntieri tal-Lvant u tan-Nofsinhar tal-UE. L-UE għandha bżonn politika barranija komuni effettiva b'mekkanizmi aħjar biex jiġu antiċipati avvenimenti u biex jiġu identifikati malajr reazzjonijiet komuni għal sfidi komuni, u azzjonijiet komuni għall-ħtif ta' opportunitajiet li minnhom nistgħu biss nibbenefikaw bis-siġħ flimkien. L-Ewropa jeħtieġ li taħdem għalenija fejn jidhlu materji ta' sigurtà u ta' difiża u biex tiżviluppa s-sħubiji strateġiċi tagħha. L-użu koerenti u kongunt tal-istrumenti kollha disponibbli għall-Unjoni, inkluż il-politika estera u ta' sigurtà komuni (PESK) u l-projezzjoni esterna sistematika tal-politiki interni se jkunu indispensabbli biex jitmexxew 'il quddiem l-oġġettivi ta' politika tal-UE fix-xena globali.

Il-Kummissjoni ser tqis bħala prijorità l-promozzjoni tal-istabbiltà fil-fruntieri tal-Ewropa. Biex jinkiseb dan l-oġġettiv huwa essenzjali li tingħata għajnuna lill-pajjiżi ġirien fl-implimentazzjoni ta' riformi demokratiċi u ekonomiċi, fid-difiża tal-istat tad-dritt, fit-tisħiħ tal-governanza ekonomika u l-kompetittività, fl-iżvilupp tal-kapaċitajiet istituzzjonali u amministrazzjoni pubblika li tiffunzjona tajjeb u biex isiru aktar prosperi. Il-Kummissjoni se tirrevedi l-politika Ewropea tal-veċinat u tagħmel proposti għall-futur. Kif iddikjarat fil-Linji Gwida Politiċi, in-negozjati tat-tkabbir li għaddejjin se jkomplu u b'mod partikolari se jkun meħtieġ li l-Balkani tal-Punent iżommu perspettiva Ewropea, iżda ma hu se jkun hemm l-ebda tkabbir fil-ħames snin li ġejjin.

L-UE għandha rekord qawwi ta' kooperazzjoni internazzjonali u ta' provvista ta' appoġġ għall-iżvilupp u assistenza lejn bosta partijiet tad-dinja. Dan jinkludi l-promozzjoni tad-drittijiet tal-bniedem fl-azzjonijiet esterni kollha tagħna, l-indirizzar tal-inugwaljanzi u l-promozzjoni tal-ugwaljanza bejn is-sessi. Madankollu, il-politika ta' żvilupp tagħna trid ukoll tiġi adattata kontinwament għall-ħtiġijiet li dejjem qed jevolvu tal-pajjiżi shab biex jinkisbu l-aħjar riżultati għall-impenji tagħna. Bil-fatt li l-2015 hija s-Sena Ewropea tal-Iżvilupp, il-Kummissjoni se tkompli l-hidma tagħha lejn it-twettiq tal-għanijiet ta' żvilupp sostenibbli għal wara l-2015 u se tniedi riflessjonijiet dwar ir-relazzjonijiet futuri tagħha mal-pajjiżi li qed jiżviluppaw (wara Cotonou). Qed nikkontribwixxu wkoll fil-ġlieda kontra l-Ebola. Ahna

se nkompli nimmassimizzaw l-impatt tal-ghajjnuna umanitarja tagħna u ntejbu l-kapaċità tagħna ta' reazzjoni għall-kriżijiet.

10. Unjoni ta' Tibdil Demokratiku

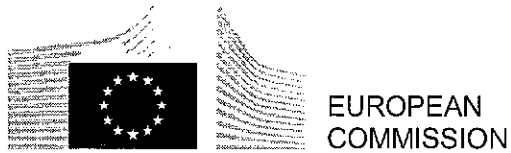
Iċ-ċittadini jistennew titjib f'dak li qed tagħmel l-UE, u kif nagħmluh. Irridu nkunu miftuha kemm jista' jkun dwar il-hidma tal-Kummissjoni, u ahna se nikkooperaw mal-istituzzjonijiet l-oħra biex intejbu r-responsabbiltà u l-aċċessibbiltà tal-azzjonijiet tal-UE. Il-Kummissjoni dahhlet fis-seħh regoli godda biex tiġi żgurata trasparenza shiha fil-kuntatti bejn il-Kummissarji u l-assoċjazzjonijiet jew individwi li jaħdmu għal rashom¹⁰, u se tressaq proposti għal Ftehim Interistituzzjonali dwar registru mandatorju ta' trasparenza, sabiex l-istituzzjonijiet Ewropej joperaw fil-miftuh fejn tidhol l-influwenza fuq il-proċess ta' tehid ta' deċiżjonijiet.

Kif imhabbar fil-linji gwida politiċi, il-Kummissjoni se tirrevedi l-proċess tat-tehid tad-deċiżjonijiet dwar l-awtorizzazzjoni tal-Organizmi Ġenetikament Modifikati (OĠM) sabiex tindirizza l-preokkupazzjonijiet taċ-ċittadini u tal-Istati Membri fir-rigward tal-obbligu legali attwali tal-Kummissjoni li tapprova l-awtorizzazzjoni ta' OĠM f'każijiet fejn maġġoranza ċara fost l-Istati Membri tkun topponi l-proposta.

Il-Kummissjoni se ttejjeb l-istrumenti tagħha għal regolazzjoni aħjar, partikolarment l-evalwazzjonijiet, il-valutazzjonijiet tal-impatt u l-konsultazzjonijiet pubbliċi tagħna, u se tidentifika gabra ulterjuri ta' azzjonijiet godda fil-kuntest tal-Programm dwar l-Idoneità tar-Regolamentazzjoni. L-istituzzjonijiet kollha jehtieg li jkunu istituzzjonijiet ta' regolamentazzjoni aħjar jekk għandna niksbu proċess legiżlattiv aktar effiċjenti fil-livell tal-UE. Għalhekk il-Kummissjoni se tippreżenta proposta għal Ftehim Interistituzzjonali ġdid dwar it-Tfassil Aħjar tal-Liġijiet. Sabiex il-prijoritajiet fejn jidhlu l-impjiegi, it-tkabbir u l-investment jiksbu r-riżultati, it-tliet istituzzjonijiet jehtieg li jaħdmu aħjar flimkien biex l-affarijiet isiru. Il-Kummissjoni qed taħdem mal-Parlament Ewropew u l-Kunsill biex itejjeb l-ipprogrammar kongunt li jrawwem is-sjieda kondiviża ta' prijoritajiet sabiex l-aġenda tal-UE titmexxa 'l quddiem bl-aktar mod effettiv, filwaqt li jiġi rispettati ir-rwol u l-prerogattivi ta' kull istituzzjoni skont it-Trattati.

Wara l-adozzjoni tal-Programm ta' Hidma 2015, il-Kummissjoni trid taħdem mal-Parlament Ewropew u mal-Kunsill biex tidentifika lista ta' proposti ta' prijorità li l-istituzzjonijiet jimpenjaw ruhhomli jagħmlu progress rapidu dwarhom u jiżguraw l-adozzjoni rapida finali tagħhom, inkluż b'mod partikolari dawk marbuta direttament mal-implimentazzjoni tal-Inizjattiva ta' investment. Flimkien nistgħu niżguraw li din id-darba se jkun hemm differenza.

Within REFIT, the Commission screens the EU's regulatory acquis and identifies necessary corrective action. These actions include legislative initiatives to simplify and reduce regulatory burden, repeals of legislation no longer needed, withdrawals of proposals without a realistic chance of adoption or where the initial objectives can no longer be achieved and evaluations and Fitness Checks to assess relevance, coherence, efficiency, effectiveness and EU added value of EU legislation and identify further opportunities for simplification and burden reduction. A first set of actions was published in October 2013 and a second set was published in June 2014. Altogether, almost 200 actions have so far been identified within the framework of REFIT and are brought together in a comprehensive scoreboard published on 18 June 2014. In this way the Commission publishes action being taken, progress made and results achieved, whilst welcoming input from all those interested, and taking their comments and suggestions into account.

The Commission's Work Programme for 2015 confirms those actions identified under REFIT that will be taken in the course of the next year. This annex includes all legislative initiatives taken under REFIT (simplification, codification/recast, consolidation, repeal, update/review) planned for Commission adoption in 2015 and all evaluations and Fitness Checks carried out under REFIT which are either ongoing or where results are expected in the course of 2015.
