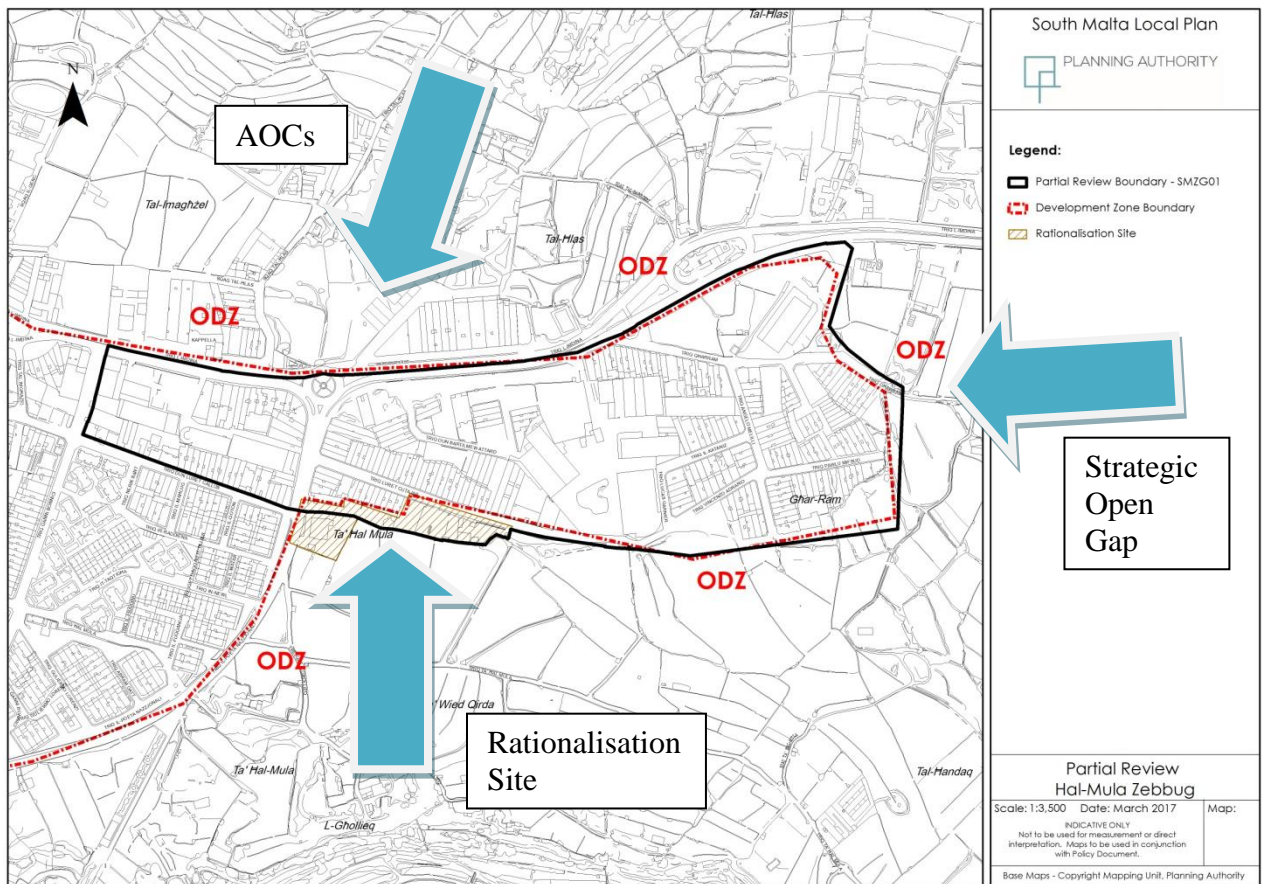


# ToR Parliamentary Query Hon. Dr G Farrugia M.P.

## 1. Nitlob li l-Awtorità taghti spjega ta' fejn hu ODZ fil-perimetru ta' pjanta bil-proposta mressqa

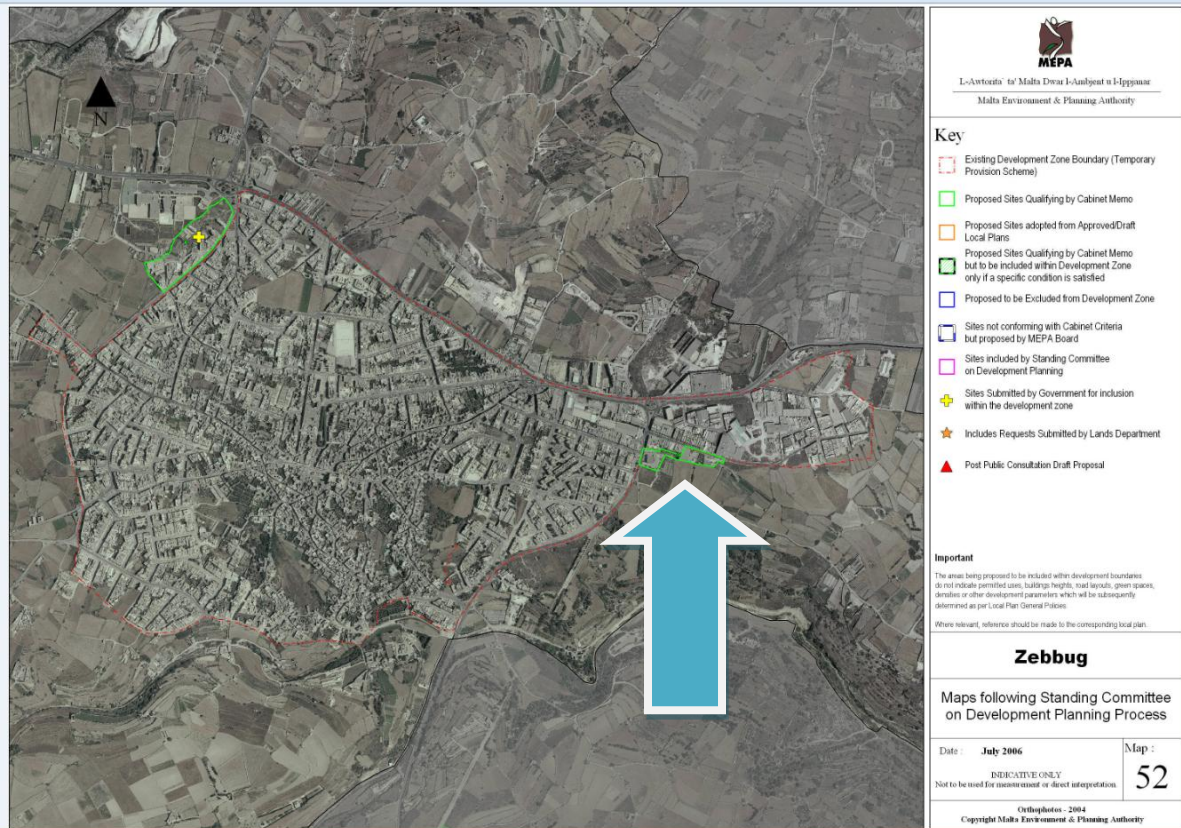
The area covered by the 'Partial Local Plan Review of the South Malta Local Plan (2006)' Area at 'Hal-Mula, Zebbug' as indicated in attached Map below is bordered by Outside Development Zone (ODZ) land mainly consisting of open fields and existing/or schemed roads.



There is also however:

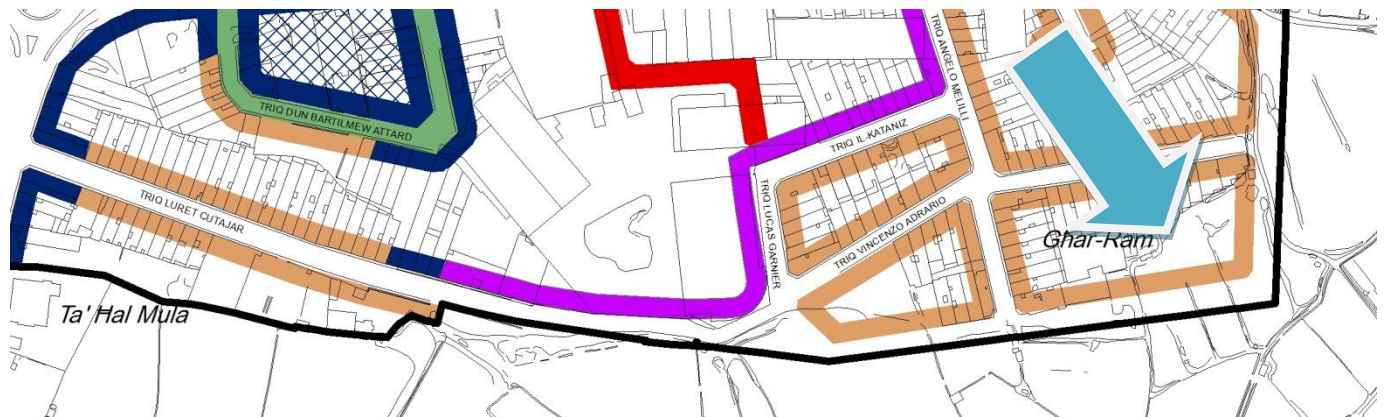
- A. A Strategic Open Gap between Hal-Mula Zebbug and Ghar-Ram Qormi
- B. 2 areas consisting of Areas of Containment ODZ to the north of Triq L-Imdina planned through PC54/10 and PC55/10; and

C. an area to the south of Triq Luret Cutajar that consists of a Rationalisation Exercise Site as per Map 52 **Rationalisation of Development Zone Boundaries (July 2006)** attached below



**2. La Triq Luret Cutajar tinfetah biex tinghaqad maż-żewġ partijiet eżistenti tal-lum, il-permessi tal-bini li ser jinghataw x'ser ikunu?**

The Partial Review is recommending that the blocks facing the still unopened part of Triq Luret Cutajar be zoned as Residential zoning (*see attached Inset Map below*)



**3. Hemm hsieb li f'art li hi tal-Gvern jew tal-Joint Office tinholoq wesa' pubblika?**

Within the current Draft Partial Review there is no such zoning and such data would need to be requested from the Lands Department/Joint Office. However, the Plan is still subject to change and open to public consultation, so such proposals can still be taken into consideration.

**4. Il-parti ta' Gharram kif ser tinghaqad mal-parti ta' Hal Qormi? Din ser tkun triq li l-perimetru taghha hu ODZ?**

Within the current Draft Partial Review there are no planned roads intended to join the Hal-Mula<sup>1</sup> Zebbug area to Ghar-Ram in Qormi. The Hal-Mula area will continue to be accessed from Triq L-Imdina. The area in between Zebbug and Qormi is currently zoned as a Strategic Open Gap where no road development is proposed.

<sup>1</sup> The area under study has been referred to as Hal-Mula and not Ghar-Ram for ease of reference as other PA reviews refer to Ghar-Ram in Qormi (namely PC53/10)
